ON JUNE 6, 2010, THE BY-ELECTION AND THE TOUR DE L'ÎLE DE MONTRÉAL WILL BE SHARING THE SPOTLIGHT

The by-election for the office of mayor and city councillor of Rivière-des-Prairies–Pointe-aux-Trembles will be held on June 6.

The Tour de l'Île de Montréal will also be held on June 6. Several streets in the sector of Rivière-des-Prairies will thus be closed between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Polling stations will be open from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m.

Workers from Élection Montréal and Vélo Québec Événements, producer of the Tour de l'Île de Montréal, will be on hand to ensure proper access to polling stations at all times.

Élection Montréal and Vélo Québec Événements will be working closely to avoid undue delays, but traffic around certain polling stations may nevertheless be disrupted. Electors who so wish may exercise their right to vote at the advance poll on Sunday, May 30, from noon to 8 p.m.
