NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is given to the electors of Saint-Léonard-Est district of Saint-Léonard borough that:

1. Nominations for the office of city councillor of Saint-Léonard-Est district are now open.
2. Nomination papers are available at the Office of the Returning Officer, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est, ground floor, Montréal, as well as at the borough election office of Saint-Léonard, 8712, boulevard Langelier. Nomination papers are also available at mycitymyvote.ca.

Nomination papers for the office of city councillor, as a member of an authorized party or as an independent candidate, must be filed in the Office of the Returning Officer or in the borough election office, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., **between January 31 and 4:30 p.m. on February 14, 2020.**

Take note that on **Friday, February 14**, last day to fill the nomination papers, offices will be open **from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. without interruption.**

3. If more than one candidate is running for office, a poll will be held on Sunday, March 15, 2020, from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. An advance poll will be held on Sunday, March 8, 2020, from noon to 8 p.m. Other special measures are being taken to ensure that everyone is able to exercise his or her right to vote. Make sure you are informed.
4. I have appointed M^e Emmanuel Tani-Moore as election clerk.

The Returning Officer, M^e Emmanuel Tani-Moore and Sylvie Aubin as assistant returning officer, may receive the nomination papers.
