PUBLIC NOTICE

To sole owners of an immovable, sole occupants of a business establishment, undivided co-owners of an immovable and co-occupants of a business establishment, in Saint-Léonard-Est district, Saint-Léonard borough

NOTICE is given to **sole owners of an immovable and sole occupants of a business establishment** who are not already entitled to be entered on the list of electors as domiciled persons, that they must meet the following conditions to be entered on the list of electors of Montréal:

1. be 18 or over on **March 15, 2020**;
2. on **January 28, 2020**, be a natural person, a Canadian citizen and neither be under curatorship nor under any conviction for an offence constituting a corrupt electoral practice;
3. on **January 28, 2020**, have been the sole owner of an immovable or the sole occupant of a business establishment on the concerned territory of Montréal for at least 12 months;
4. have filed with the returning officer, at the address shown below, an application for entry on the list of electors of Montréal, **by February 9, 2020**.

Sole owners and occupants who wish to withdraw from the electoral list the existing entry, shall transmit to the returning officer, at the address shown below, a signed writing requesting the withdrawal by **February 9, 2020**.

NOTICE is also given to **undivided co-owners of an immovable and co-occupants of a business establishment** who are not already entitled to be entered on the list of electors as domiciled persons, as sole owners of an immovable or as sole occupants of a business establishment, that they must meet the following conditions to be entered on the list of electors of Montréal:

1. be 18 or over on **March 15, 2020**;
2. on **January 28, 2020**, be a natural person, a Canadian citizen and neither be under curatorship nor under any conviction for an offence constituting a corrupt electoral practice;

3. on **January 28, 2020**, have been the undivided co-owner of an immovable or the co-occupant of a business establishment on the concerned territory of Montréal for at least 12 months;
4. have been designated under a power of attorney signed by the majority of co-owners or co-occupants who are qualified to vote on **January 28, 2020**;
5. have filed a power of attorney with the returning officer, at the address shown below, **by February 9, 2020**.

Co-owners and co-occupants who wish to replace the existing designation shall transmit to the returning officer, at the address shown below, a new power of attorney by **February 9, 2020**.

An application for entry, withdrawal or a power of attorney filed **after February 9, 2020, but no later than February 24, 2020, at 10 p.m.**, the last day to file an application with the board of revisors, will be considered as an application for correction to the list of electors, and consequently, will be submitted to the board of revisors.

Applications for entry and power of attorney forms are available from the returning officer or on the website. Applications for entry and powers of attorney take effect on receipt and remain valid as long as they are not withdrawn or replaced.
